Fred Reinagel Since moving to Tucson in February 2007, Fred has sung with the *Arizona Repertory Singers*, *Musica Sonora*, the *Tucson Symphony Orchestra Chorus*, and the *U of A*

Collegium Musicum. In his former life in Western New York, he sang in numerous choral groups, as well as directing several church choirs and the *Fort Erie Community Chorus*. Fred is the founder of The Vail Chorale.
