At University of Alabama in Huntsville and Birmingham Southern College, she studied Voice Performance, accompanied the Women's Chorus, and continued singing in the College Choir, the Village Singers, and Music Ambassadors (a scholarship program). She has performed with choirs and ensembles in the U.S., Mexico, Guatemala, and Europe. Melissa served as Assistant Director with The Vail Chorale from its inception in 2011.

Our Accompanist, Sujie Zhao, who was born and raised in China, has been playing piano since the age of 5. In Fall 2021, Sujie started pursuing her Ph.D. in collaborative piano at the University of Arizona under the guidance of Dr. Fanya Lin. At the U. of A., she has accompanied the UA Wind Ensemble and is currently the accompanist for the University of Arizona Choir of Collegium Musicum.
