The mission of the Vail Performing Arts Society is to create experiences that move, enrich and inspire by connecting people in the community through outreach and the performing arts.



Accomplishments:

1. Name Change from Vail Performing Arts Society successfully changed to The Vail Chorale
 - a. EXCEPTION, The IRS name change is still in the works. We MIGHT have to get Udall (Julie's lawyer group) involved.
2. Spring Concert 2024 – membership numbers were up following the lifting of COVID 19 vaccine requirements
 - a. Venue location swap: Del Webb on Saturday and ASA on Sunday, was a little challenging but overall went well.
3. Fall concert 2024- membership numbers continue to be increased;
 - a. venue locations back to normal
 - b. We were made aware that we may be permanently swapping venues moving forward
 - c. We purchased and implemented the use of 4 wireless microphones and updated capells
4. We were able to participate in two holiday events, the annual Tis the Season event and the Holidays at Town Center event, where we received \$200 for our performance!
5. We sent a Thank You letter and gift to Mrs Lam; we received a positive response and another large donation.
6. While we struggled finding a permanent accompanist, we found ourselves overwhelmed with support with the return of Hanna Gregg and Mike Melton and additional support from April Layher.
7. We were also made aware that our Director may have to vacate her position last Fall due to her family commitments, it turned out she managed to stay and has put together some amazing programs.
